Ordained as a PC(USA) Minister of Word and Sacrament in 1984, Ken has served as Pastor of Onondaga Hill Presbyterian Church in Syracuse, New York; Co-Pastor (along with his wife Judy) of Beulah Presbyterian Church in Louisville, Kentucky; and Pastor of Carter-Westminster United Presbyterian Church in Skokie, Illinois. He received his MDiv from Princeton Theological Seminary and also holds a Bachelor of Music from Grove City College. Ken is married to Rev. Judy Hockenberry, and they have three adult children.
